

Practice 1: 7 Days orientation programme for newly appointed teachers

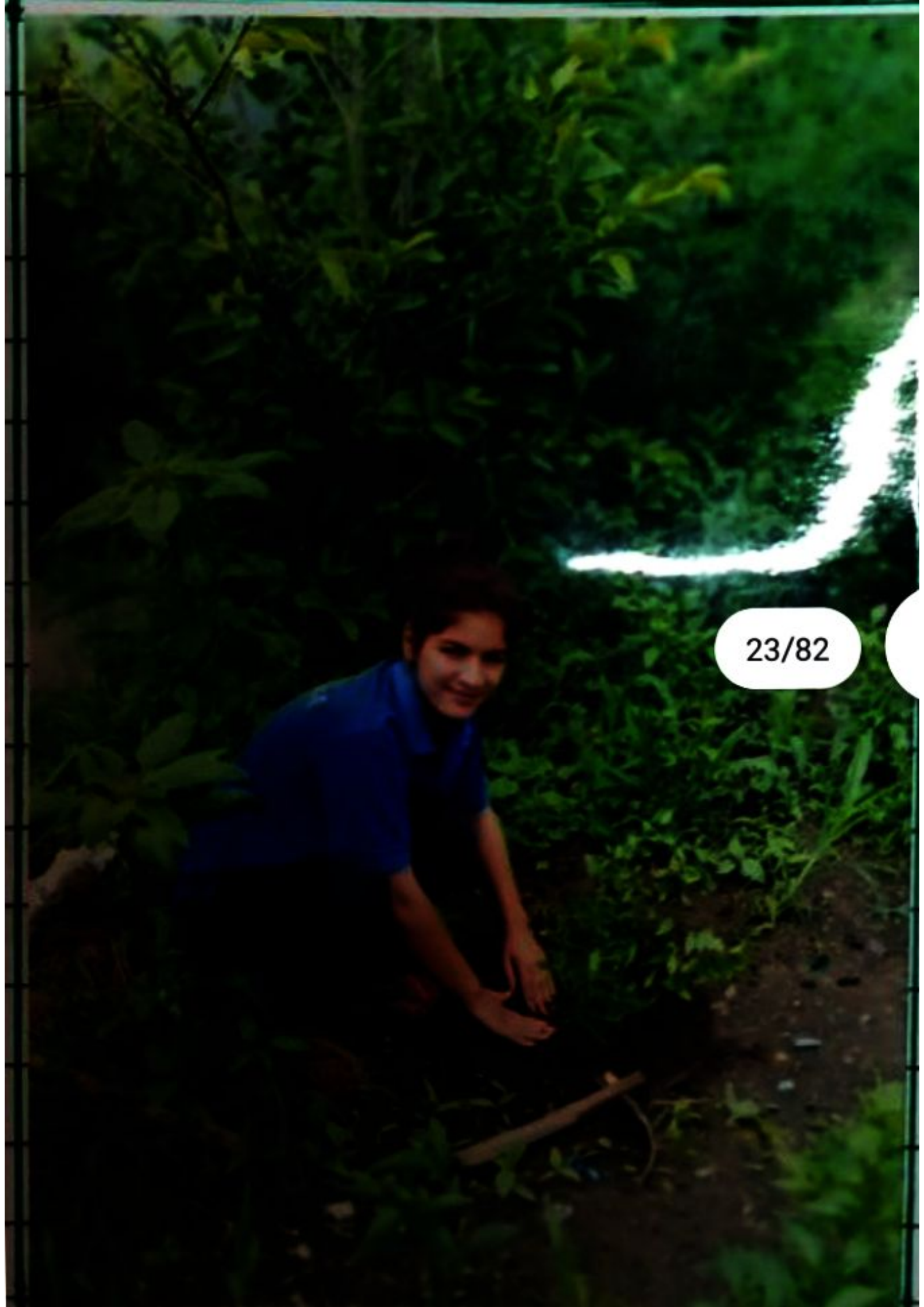
